# Who is HELEN ZIA you ask???

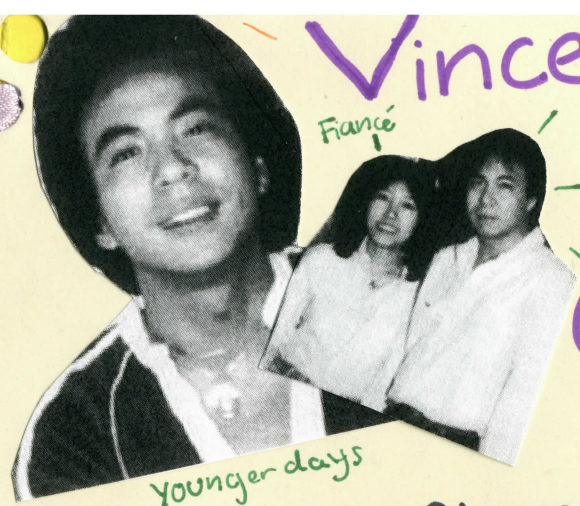
Born in NEWARK, NJ in 1952, Helen Zia is a Chinese-American who lived through the 2<sup>nd</sup> wave of FEMINISM & onto the 3<sup>rd</sup>. She lived through a time period where Asian-Americans had lots of "heat" directed towards them. She also was one of the few Asian-Americans at Princeton in the 1970s, and also was a member of the first graduating class of WOMEN!

She went from med. school at Tufts Uni to dropping out to be a construction laborer. [SHATTERING ASIAN STEREOTYPES OF ASIANS-700s!] She later found her voice and calling in Journalism and writing.

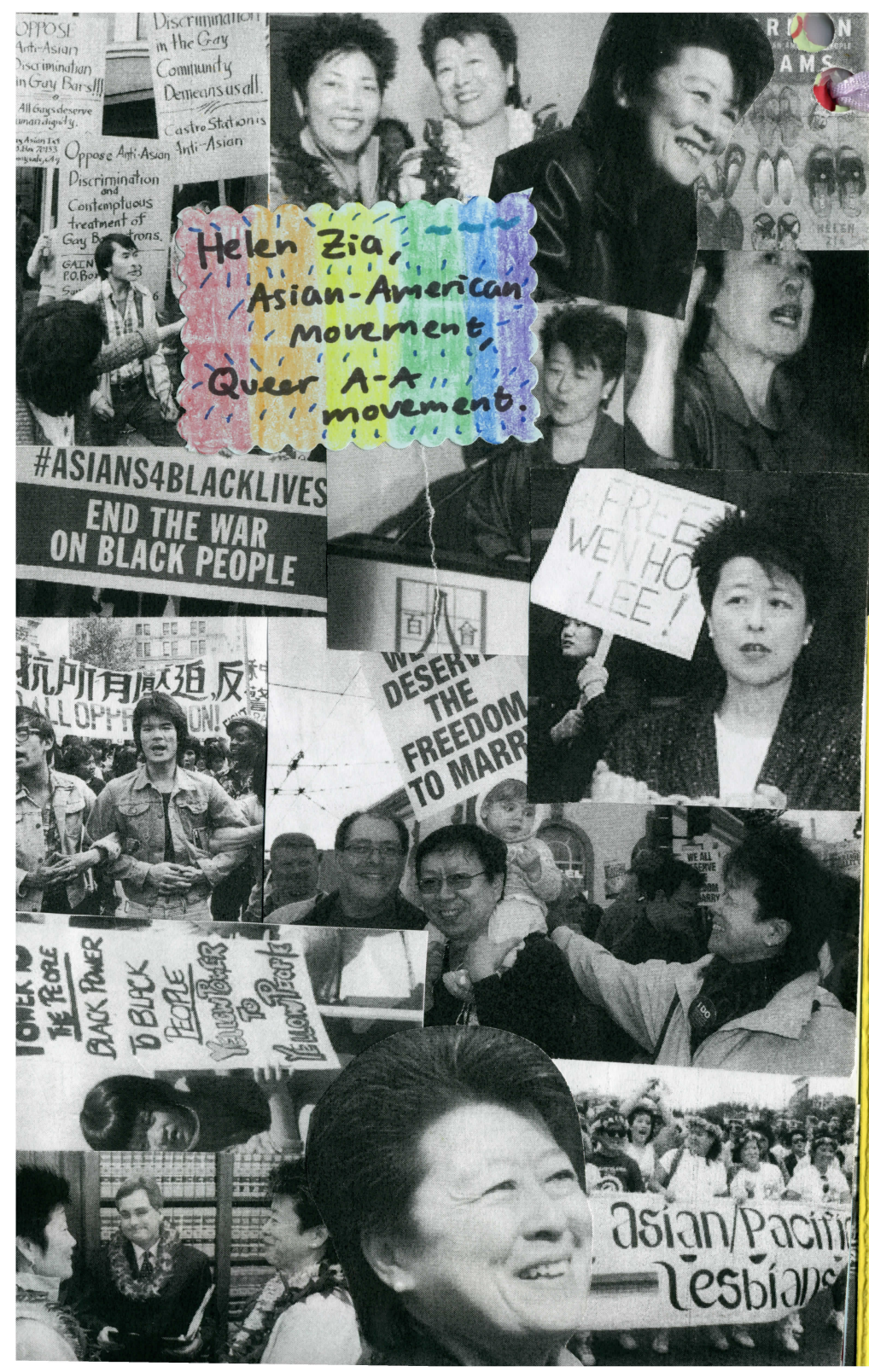
# Vincent Jen Chin



Vincent Chin was a Chinese-American man who was mistaken for a Japanese-American and was murdered because of anti-Japanese sentiment! He was beaten w/ a baseball bat on the night of his Bachelor party. His murderers yelled out, "It's because of you little motherfuckers that we're out of work!" - referring to the U.S. manufacturing auto jobs being lost to Japan. The murderers received no jail time, 3 yrs. probation, and \$3000 fines. Helen Zia and Liza Chan fought for federal charges - it sparked anger in the A-A community! This



Case brought the AA community together and showed how messed up the justice system is. Hate crimes were brought to the spotlight after for A-A community!

**Q: What is the Chicana Feminist movement?**

A: White women refused to address racism in their organization. NOC were forced to choose between their culture and being a women. "Mujer Mala" came about as Chicanas became more independent. They were seen as anti-men, anti-culture, and anti-family.

**Q: How is Chicana Feminism unique?**

A: Also written as "xicanism" and is meant to challenge traditional Mexican-American tropes regarding gender, ethnicity, class, race, sexuality, etc.



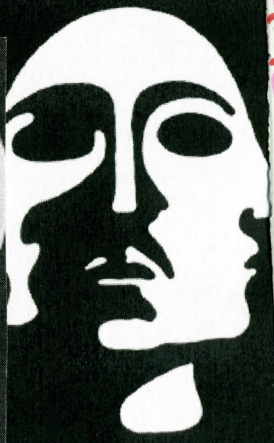




Q: What does **chicana** mean?

A: First coined during the Chicano Movement in the 1960s. Refers to a Mexican-American woman raised in the U.S. These women are often seen in poverty and face sexism & racism in the U.S., but also within their own culture.

# Why we should know her

1. She is known as the first Filipina historian and the first Filipina to obtain a doctoral degree in the Philippines!

2. By 1928, she became president of the Philippine Association of University Women, which focused on granting women the power to vote.



3. She wrote a book called, *The Filipino Woman: Her Social, Economic and Political Status in 1934* to promote her campaign for women's suffrage in the Philippines.

4. Alzona's writings garnered social and political support leading to the passing of an election bill that granted females the right to vote in 1937!

Before women's suffrage was passed, Encarcion Alzona hosted tea parties for members of the legislature in order to convince them to grant women such rights!

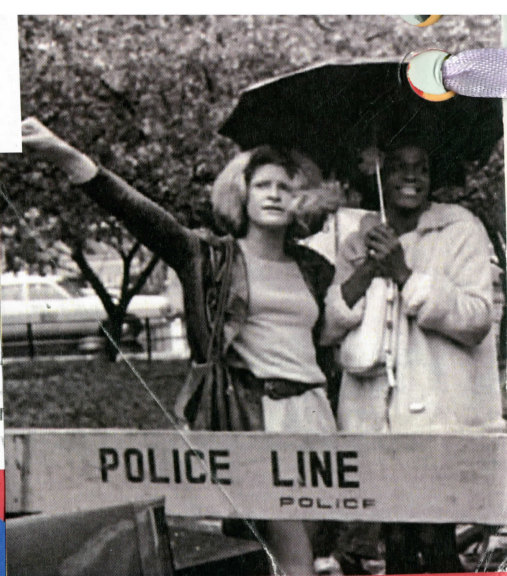

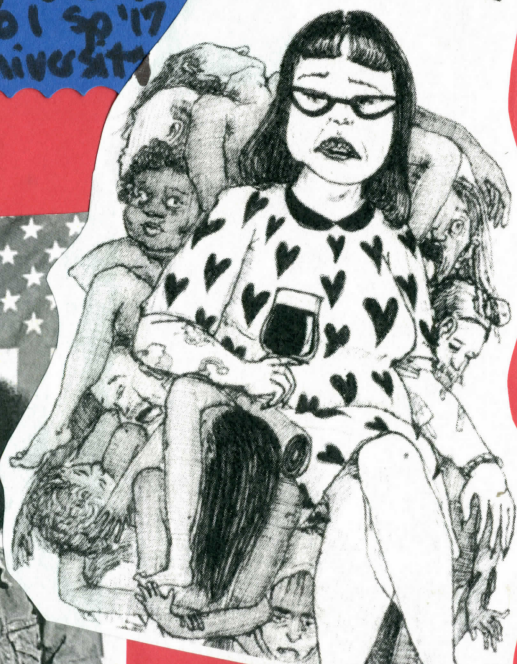
