





American Sexual Education Requirements As OF May 1, 2017:

- · 24 states and the District of Columbia mandate sex education
- 22 states and the District of columbia mondate both sex and HIV education
- 27 states and the District of columbia mondate that, when provided, sex and HIV education programs meet certain general requirements
- 13 states require that the instruction be MEDICALLY ACCURATE

Teens Reports of formal sexual health eaucation

- Declines in formal sex education were concentrated among addiescents residing in rural areas
- Many sexually experienced teens do not receive formal instruction about contraception BEFORE they first have sex; fewer received instruction about where to get himborium
