women have been victims of  
attempted or completed rape.

males aged 18-24 are 5x more likely to be  
sexually assaulted if they are students  
than if they are non-students.



women are 5x more likely to be sexually  
assaulted when they are 18-24 than any  
other age.

63% of sexual assaults are not reported.

91% of victims are female! 89% of  
campuses disclosed zero  
reported incidents of rape.

31% suffer academically

22% consider leaving school

44% struggle with peers

1. we believe you.

2. it's not your fault.

3. you are not alone.

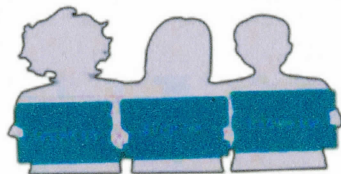
